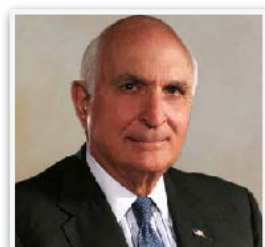
The Carlyle family wealth-holder community includes 250 families & 900 members from around the world, with combined investible assets approaching \$180 billion.

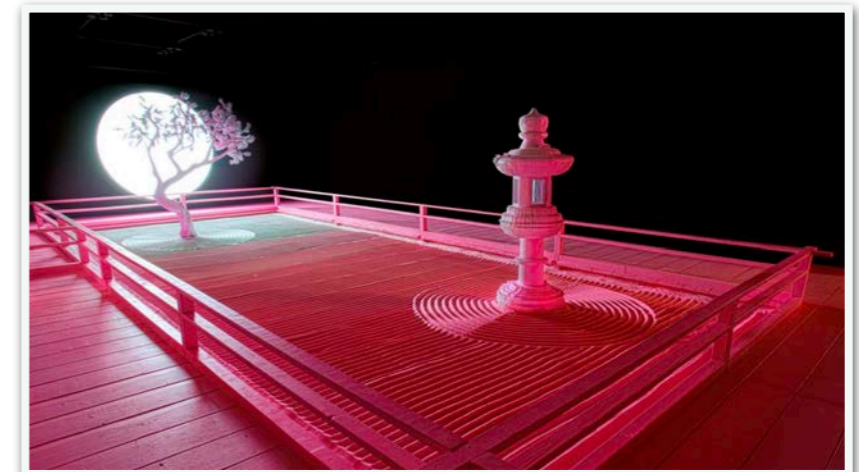

Westminster Abbey is an important treasure house of art, sculpture, tapestries, and artifacts - Carlyle guests will have the privilege of seeing select works.

Since 1066, forty monarchs have been crowned in Westminster Abbey, including King Charles's coronation on the May 6th, 2023.



The Abbey has also celebrated sixteen royal weddings, the most recently His Royal Highness Prince William married Catherine Middleton at the Abbey on 29th April 2011.

The Abbey is the final resting place of 17 monarchs including Queen Elizabeth 1, together with remembrance services and funerals for historical figures such as Sir Isaac Newton, Jane Austen, Charles Dickens, Stephen Hawking, and Martin Luther King and Diana, Princess of Wales.



Kensington Palace is our host for an extraordinary gala experience, celebrating Carlyle's signature philanthropy initiative, 'Nurse Heroes'. This once-in-a-lifetime occasion, hosted across four State rooms of the Palace, begins with an elegant cocktail reception in the King's Drawing Room & Cupola Room.

Our seated concert will take place in the historic Kings Gallery - the largest of the state apartments, it looks almost exactly as it did when it was transformed for George I in 1725.
